



GatherGuard Transition Information

The **TULIP Program** is slowly being replaced by a new product called **GatherGuard**. GatherGuard works very much like TULIP only better. It has an enhanced website dedicated just to GatherGuard, which includes some great new features that everyone can appreciate. Here are a few examples:

- **Flexible GL Policy Limits**
 - Standard GL limit options are \$1M /\$2M. Limits up to \$5M are available upon request.
 - Each venue may set its own limits.
- **Venue ID Codes and Referral Links**
 - GatherGuard requires that a venue ID code be issued to each property expected to be rented out to event holders.
 - In addition to the venue ID code, GatherGuard will also issue referral link. Referral links may be added to the venue's website where event holders may have direct access. Clicking on the link places the event holder directly into the online application and auto-fills venue information.
- **Terrorism Risk Insurance Act (TRIA)**
 - TRIA is now included in all policies at no charge.
- **Proof of Coverage and Policies**
 - In addition to a certificate of insurance, GatherGuard will issue a complete policy in the name of the event holder.
- **Multi-Day Events**
 - Multi-day events may be purchased up to 90-days out starting from the first event date.

To get your pool started on the transition to GatherGuard, the team will need the attached venue worksheet (GatherGuard Template 2022) to be returned. When you fill this out, keep in mind to just pick the venues that are most likely to be used for events. The address MUST be able to be found in "Google Maps". For example, if your police department happens to have a conference room, but you don't rent it out to the general public, then don't add it here. Also, it is a good idea to have one generic location, such as your city/town hall to be used for things like parades or events that take place in areas where there is no address. When naming the facility, use the name that a person would use doing a "Google Search". We found from this experience and even doing the property schedules that someone might refer to a building as the recreation center, someone else calls it the community center, etc.

Once you get your venue list back to HUB, they will get it over to the GatherGuard staff and they will get you set up. Once they have your venues, GatherGuard will give you Venue ID Codes and referral links for each venue which you can list on your website.
