

2015 Risk Management Committee Highlights

The Committee is responsible for the review and approval of technical loss control guidelines, for advising the Underwriting Committee of a Member's deviation from those guidelines, for setting requirements for the admission of Members to the pools, and for reviewing LGIT's claim history to analyze loss control needs.

During Fiscal Year 2015 the Risk Management Committee approved the following:

- The Education/Training Grant Program awarded **32 grants** for a total amount of **\$83,058.00**
- The Law Enforcement Body Camera Grant Program awarded **10 Grants** for a total amount of **\$15,608.42**
- The 2015 Law Enforcement Memorial Training Grant was awarded to the **City of Brunswick** in the amount of **\$5,000.00**
