This workshop is for those with little to moderate experience in supervising employees. It will give beginning supervisors valuable information that will help them gain confidence in supervising and managing their staff.

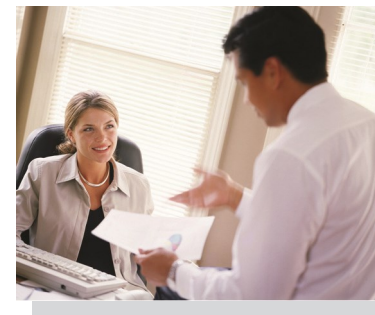
